
the afternoon instead of a whole school disco. Thank you for your support and understanding.

Dear Parents,

Advent is approaching... Everything is a little different this year – but nothing will deter us from buying our Christmas trees, will it? The Parents Association at Our Lady and St Joseph School would like to do their bit and are offering lovely Christmas trees at reduced prices. Same supplier as last year and the trees were gorgeous. Are you in? Profits from trees sold to De Beauvoir School parents will be going to De Beauvoir School.

How it works: The Our Lady and St Joseph PA buys the trees at wholesale prices. We then sell them at a profit, but still significantly cheaper than at many garden centres. e.g. if a 6-7ft Nordman Fir at the wholesale price of \pounds 32.50 inc. VAT, in a garden centre these will retail for about \pounds 60-72.00, but we will sell them for \pounds 45.00. And we still make a profit, which goes to benefit our schools so it's a win-win!
