SCHOOL UNIFORM REMINDER

Navy sweatshirt or cardigan with/without the school logo;

Plain black, closed toe footwear (not higher than the ankle, no trainers or raised platforms or jelly shoes);

Small plain silver or gold studs should be worn in pierced ears, otherwise all earrings should be removed;

Hair accessories should be grey, navy or black.

Please name removable clothing to avoid property being lost at school.

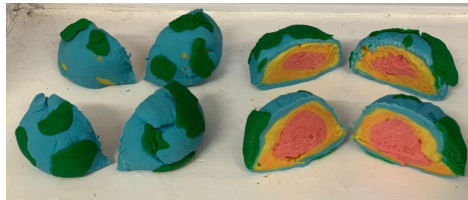
