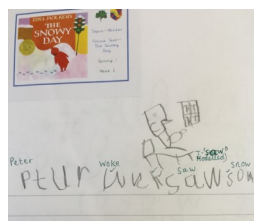
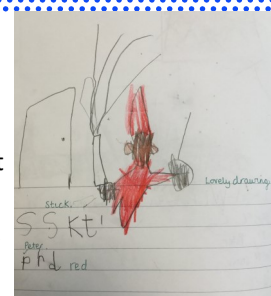

Being on time helps your child have a settled start to the day and prevents missed learning. Here are the percentage of late marks by class last week:

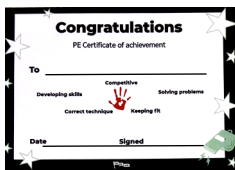

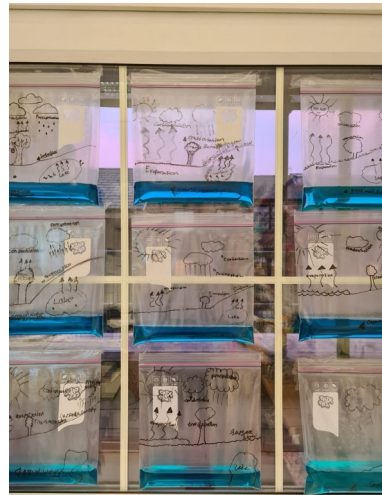
