Dear Parents/Carers of Fig Class,

At De Beauvoir, we love to read and we want all of our pupils to develop a love of learning and a love of books. We do daily reading with all pupils between 9-10am, for Reception and KS1, this involves **Read Write Inc Phonics** and for KS2 pupils, this will be whole class and individual reading.

In Fig Class, it is essential that all families are reading at home. The Fig Class Team are sending home new books **twice a week in reading packs**, as well as phonetically decodable readers for Reception pupils. Spending 10 minutes a day reading to your child helps them develop social and emotional skills and become confident, happy learners.

Please can we ask that book bags and reading folders are brought to school **daily** to enable pupils to build their independence and ensure they are changing their reading books regularly. We understand that for many families, mornings can be a rush in order to get to school on time, however, bringing book bags and reading packs to school will start a habit that will support their reading for many years.
