NON-UNIFORM DAY AND SPRING DISCO FOR DCE UKRAINE APPEAL

On **Monday 28th March**, pupils are invited to wear yellow and blue clothes to school to raise money for the Disasters Emergency Committee Ukraine Humanitarian Appeal. A **voluntary donation of £1** should be brought to school and pupils will be doing a range of activities during the day to reflect on the current situation in Ukraine and understand the challenges faced by children and families fleeing their homes. We will have a disco after school on that day, and we will be using the **£1 ticket price** for the Spring Disco to further raise money for the DCE charity.

RED NOSE DAY—THIS FRIDAY 18th March 2022

Red Nose Day is coming. We will be having a **non-uniform day** to help raise money enabling people to live free from poverty, violence and discrimination. This includes funding organisations that are supporting people right now in Ukraine, and those attempting to cross the border. You can wear red, your own clothes or even dress up in a costume—just remember sensible shoes and a **£1 donation**.

Your donation could pay for:

£30 could support a child in Uganda to access early years education for a whole year.

£50 could pay to get 200 meals to vulnerable children and families in the UK.

£100 could provide four counselling sessions for a new parent in the UK experiencing mental health problems.
